### 7. Vice Chair Report

- 3 tech fee subsidies sent out through slack:
- Nueva Herencia Baile event with food and drinks, February 22nd, estimated attendance: 150, amount requested: \$300, amount recommended: \$150 - 7 approved, 0 denied

- TEDx Ted talk hosted and food and activities included in event, February 24th, estimated attendance: 65, amount requested: \$400, amount recommended: \$130 - 6 approved, 0 denied
- Serotones/Skaggs School of Pharmacy Hosting a charity concert with music but focusing on Skaggs, February 28th, estimated attendance: 100, amount requested: \$475, recommended amount: \$200 - 5 approved, 0 denied

- Event open to public, confusion on that confirmed with John, when event is open to public it includes all students not just students in the club
- Sent message to tech fee subsidies application worker to change wording and reflects fact that if event is open to all students or just students in the club, clears up any confusion for clubs when they apply

### 8. Executive Director Report (Interim John Payne)

- Campus leadership meetings, they are doing their best to keep up with changes on federal level, very complicated, moves a little differently every day
- Trying to keep up and communicate it, if you have any questions feel free to reach out but most is updated on websites as soon as things are known
- Marketing promoting graduation through price center, signage class of 2025
- How to celebrate it/upcoming graduates? Ideas are welcome
- Shores Diner is really struggling, encourage students or try to get feedbacks on why they wont go there, encourage student events in Stage room, full tech set up in there
- Holly Does booking the stage room generally help Shores?
- John Yes, it helps because it generates more traffic and more people tend to go
- Elijah Has the booking fee increased or is the price cheaper?
- John I'm pretty sure it has stayed the same since last time, most of our leases say that a vendor can't increase from 10%
- Pamela Do you have a reason as to why traffic is so low at Shores?
- John No but we are waiting for the mystery shopper's responses to know what they are saying, it's just different, maybe the vibe before the pandemic is not the same anymore? People do not hangout in groups anymore?
- Pamela Did they get a boost when the comedian was there?

- John Yes they did and it was good but unfortunately can't be there everyday
- Shreya Do you think if we offered a 10% coupon like clubs it would increase traffic?
- John Good idea, we could work with them and have a QR code that an event uses for the day
- Also delivering food into the stage room could be a good idea as well?
- Will pick up in may and april with more caterings

#### 9. **New Business**

- Reached out by vendor who does claw machines, interested in putting one in price center
- Jess I have a lot of friends who are really into blindboxes, so a claw machines is a good idea, price center is a place to have fun
- Vitasta Would they take tritoncash?
- John No
- Shreya Would we get any earnings?
- John Yes we would, flat fee based on square footage taken by machines
- Sophia good idea because it is a new form of entertainment and would attract people onto price center
- Elijah Great idea, do you know if they would only have traditional claw machines..?
- John I'm not sure yet we just got an email
- Shreya Does anyone have specific requests, i know it is a future idea but just to be sure?
- Holly blindboxes, plushies...
- Will pursue and get more feedback and information, how many machines etc
- Triton statue relocation?
- John Working with alumni relations and triton statue on price center east, working
  with sculpture, current fountain is not great so have tried to make it really awesome but
  in course of that we have to submit it to various campus entities and feedback was given
  on relocating statue
- Folks would like to see sculpture in different locations will need the boards support if we
  want to keep statue where it is
- Emily is there a reason they don't like it in their current location?
- John No reasoning was given, just don't like it
- Some clubs offered to have it relocated to library walk or Liontree arena
- If we want to see him move to library walk, expenses would make that something that would be pushed down way down the road

- Olivia I am opposed because it is an unnecessary waste of money, people go there all
  the time and even putting it in library walk would be very tight maybe we can figure out
  why people don't like where it is before anything
- Emily People on campus tours will so often take a picture with statue so the whole location is almost right, people take photos all the time and even decorate it
- Elijah It's a silly but not a good idea at all if we want to put something on library walk it could be something else
- John Just wanted to put it out there and see how you all felt about that idea that was put out so randomly but I will keep you posted if anything changes
- Pamela When talking about enhancing the statue, when is the timeline?
- John Well, the concept drawing is done and rough pricing, rough architectural detail done so that we can get this pricing, university center paying for soft cost and alumni will generate 250 to fund and make it a class gift, timeline was moving well until we hit this talk of relocation and no committee has given comment oversee landscape and design including arts committee
- We need them to bless design and will go back to constructions drawings and then timeline will start to move but don't know how long this will take to hash out, fundings will start potentially soon

#### 10. Old Business

- Starbucks lease renewal have there been any updates from club councils?
- Olivia last time we talked about doing a broader survey so next week we are having events on ERC and will be having an income of about 150 opinion responses
- People like idea of having starbucks on campus because it is an easily available coffee spot, people just want good coffee in center of campus
- App on phone makes it convenient
- Vitasta Talking to my council is one sided, also asked individuals and many said
  yes if they really need coffee and nothing else is really available but down to have
  a better coffee place (better buzz, pete's,etc)
- Elijah survey brought up to council, most of the people I talked to really wanted a dutch bros because the menu has a lot of options
- John It is a bit more difficult to have those type of businesses like Dutch Bros to want to work with us
- More questions that are john oriented, how much money does Starbucks make, employees etc any questions?
- Shreya Do you mind telling us how was it before starbucks
- John Around 10 years ago or so there was a vendor called "Cafe Roma," served pre-made bagels and coffees, had a lot of demands but they weren't meeting

- that, couple opportunities given but did not listen, that is when UCAB made decision to bring starbucks and have us be franchise and operate it
- The amount of energy effort goes into starbucks for very little profit in 10 years wont pay back reconstruction, does not make sense from financial standpoint for university center to run starbucks
- What is the real thing people are looking for? Speed of service? Conveniences?
   Options?
- What makes Starbucks so efficient and popular is the mobile app
- How many other places have a convenient app...?
- Vitasta 85 coffee at UTC has a mobile app and it is really good
- Cannot make it a kitchen space, limited to what type of food preparation can happen in that space
- Have not reached to anyone because we must determine what we want to do beforehand
- If we stay with starbucks and brought a different franchise, the downtime in the space is very minimum, but if we have to go through full remodel it would take around a year and a half, so basically all that time without a coffee place while we transition, not as simple as switching the signs
- Ask questions: what do you prioritize? Where do you go the majority of time to get your coffee?
- Let people know how long it may take if we were to get another place, yes people are excited when change is mentioned but might get deflated about an 18 month wait
- Emily Curious about what did not help "Cafe Roma"
- John Very few demeaning qualities especially in last couple years of existence, little effort into their job
- Elijah I research a bit about coffee shops last couple times, dutch bros is fast and organized, from my experience starbucks has taken around 10-15 to complete my order
- Gabriella I've heard that Dutch Bros is expanding more and maybe adding one to campus would be good
- Most Dutch Bros want a drive thru, it would be a much harder negotiation that some other coffee vendor if that is the choice
- Holly Could also see if there is a dutch bros in any other campus to see how that would play out
- One survey has to be made in order to tell what it is that students want and what they prioritize in a coffee business

- Ask where they get their coffee, not what they'd like to see, to know what would actually be in business
- Su-Pan lease renewal, what do members think of SuPan in general?
- Shreya always positive and good interactions, their price points are really nice
- Vitasta I've never been there but I always hear people talk about it in a very positive way
- Emily A lot of people/staff get SuPan for meetings, among staff circles it's widely enjoyed
- John SuPan does okay for what they're allowed to do, provide a wonderful part to campus, easy to work with
- Motion to start a vote to see if we renew SuPans lease renewal: Vitasta begins motion, 9 approved and 0 denied (Motion Passes and SuPan will continue on their lease)
